- HB 3054

- HB 2115  
CARREID OVER FROM THE 3/21/2013 AGENDA - Expands offense of driving while under influence of intoxicants to include any drug that adversely affects person's physical or mental faculties to noticeable or perceptible degree.
- HB 2627  
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/21/2013 AGENDA - Permits court to vacate judgment after termination of driving while under influence of intoxicants diversion agreement under certain conditions.
- HB 2335 \*\*  
Increases period of supervision required when person is convicted of promoting prostitution or compelling prostitution. \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
- HB 2594  
Modifies standard for court commitment of person with mental illness.
