- HB 2014 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Requires Department of State Police to conduct study on issues related to abduction of children.
- HB 2548 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Establishes commercial bail system.
- HB 2774 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Repeals sunset on Task Force on Victims' Rights Enforcement.
- HB 3278
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Permits appellate court to vacate juvenile court judgment or order and remand to juvenile court for reconsideration.
- SB 93
Authorizes Department of Corrections to make grants to counties for provision of reentry support and services to certain offenders under 19 years of age.
- SB 187
Modifies time period within which Department of Corrections must comply with court's direction to prepare certain proposed release plans.
