HB 3201 A

Allows person holding interest in property to recover economic and property damages resulting from fire occurring due to certain statutory or rule violations or resulting from fire escaping from land used or capable of being used for growing forest tree species.

HB 3282

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Requires trial court to issue written orders in certain victims' rights proceedings. **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means HB 3283 **

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Increases maximum allowable balance of Criminal Justice Revolving Account. HB 3286

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Eliminates transcription requirement for warrants based on sworn oral statements. HB 3287

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Requires party in post-conviction relief proceeding to disclose witness information to opposing party at least 90 days prior to hearing.
