#### Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- HB 3048  
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Requires that sexually explicit material involving minor remain in control of law enforcement agency or court throughout criminal or juvenile proceeding, provided that material is made reasonably available to defendant.
- HB 3198  
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Requires justice or municipal court to notify Department of State Police when court enters judgment of conviction of Class A misdemeanor.
- HB 3213  
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Adds financial loss from recovering stolen vehicle to list of injuries compensable under crime victims' compensation program.
- HB 3253  
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Requires sex offender who is released into Oregon, who is placed on probation in Oregon or who moves into Oregon, to register as sex offender if jurisdiction of conviction requires registration, regardless of whether conviction would be sex crime in this state.
- HB 3422  
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Creates crimes of drug-induced homicide and drug-induced assault.

#### Work Session

- HB 2549 \*\*  
Directs Department of Corrections to establish risk assessment tool applicable to sex offenders. \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
- HB 2552  
Eliminates obligation to report as sex offender if person is required to report solely as result of juvenile court adjudication for act committed when person was under 16 years of age.
- HB 2595  
Creates crime of interference with state forestland management in the second degree.
