Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- HB 2557
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Directs trier of fact in civil action to compare fault of claimant with fault of all third party defendants, whether or not third party defendant is liable to claimant.
- HB 2556
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Provides that rate of interest on judgments that exceed \$1 million is lesser of five percent per annum or three percentage points more than discount rate in effect at Federal Reserve Bank in Federal Reserve district that includes Oregon.
- HB 2581
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Increases amount of noneconomic damages that may be awarded in civil action seeking damages arising out of bodily injury.
- HB 2668
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Expands definition of "place of public accommodation" to include places owned or maintained by public body and services provided by public body.
- HB 2834
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Enacts Revised Uniform Law on Notarial Acts.

Work Session

- HB 3201 A
Allows person holding interest in property to recover economic and property damages resulting from fire occurring due to certain statutory or rule violations or resulting from fire escaping from land used or capable of being used for growing forest tree species.
