#### Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- HB 3198  
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4/01/2013 AGENDA - Requires justice or municipal court to notify Department of State Police when court enters judgment of conviction of Class A misdemeanor.
- HB 3253  
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4/01/2013 AGENDA - Requires sex offender who is released into Oregon, who is placed on probation in Oregon or who moves into Oregon, to register as sex offender if jurisdiction of conviction requires registration, regardless of whether conviction would be sex crime in this state.
- HB 2962  
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Requires court finding of prejudice for violations of speedy trial requirement.
- HB 3277  
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Allows prosecuting attorneys 90 days after sentencing to present restitution information to court.
- HB 3280  
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Appropriates moneys to Department of Justice for Restitution Collection Pilot Program.
- HB 3281  
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Requires all agents of defense to inform victim of right to refuse contact in criminal and post-conviction proceedings.
