#### Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- HB 2384  
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Authorizes civil forfeiture of motor vehicle if person is convicted of offense relating to driving while suspended or revoked.
- HB 3048  
Requires that sexually explicit material involving minor remain in control of law enforcement agency or court throughout criminal or juvenile proceeding, provided that material is made reasonably available to defendant.
- HB 3184  
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Provides that charging instrument that alleges that defendant committed misdemeanor automatically be treated as charging defendant with commission of Class A violation unless prosecuting attorney elects to charge defendant with misdemeanor.
- HB 3284  
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Eliminates statute of limitations for certain sex crimes committed against minors by persons 18 years of age or older.
- HB 3327  
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Authorizes court to set aside conviction for certain sex crimes under certain circumstances.

#### Work Session

- HB 2594  
Modifies standard for court commitment of person with mental illness.
