Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- SB 49 A
Authorizes Chief Justice of Supreme Court to adopt standards and plan for physical security of judges and staff.
- SB 51 A
Modifies provisions relating to consolidation of probation violation proceedings.
- SB 141 A
Extends criminal sanctions for signing false documents for filing with office of Secretary of State to all business registry filings.
- SB 638
Approves adoption of and modifications to rules of Oregon Criminal Justice Commission.
- SB 52 A
Directs state agencies to preserve final orders in contested cases issued by agency in digital format and to provide electronic copies to Oregon State Bar, or designee, upon request.
