Work Session

- SB 40 A
Defines "marijuana" and "marijuana product."
Reduces unlawful manufacture of marijuana to Class B felony.
- SB 482 A**
Adds saliva to category of bodily substances that may not be propelled at public safety officer under aggravated harassment statute, provided that saliva comes into physical contact with public safety officer. **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
- SB 697
Prohibits person not licensed to perform tattooing from possessing equipment used for tattooing with intent to use that equipment on another person.
- SB 82 A
Eliminates suspension of driving privileges for person convicted of possessing less than one ounce of marijuana.
