Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- SB 90 A
Modifies certification system for shorthand reporters.
- SB 396
Exempts from execution debtor's right to assets held in, or right to receive payments under, medical savings account or health savings account.
- SB 463 A
Requires Oregon Criminal Justice Commission to create, upon request of member of Legislative Assembly, racial and ethnic impact statement for proposed legislation or state measure.

Work Session

- SB 46 A
Modifies statute of limitations for action against person registered to practice architecture, landscape architecture or engineering arising out of construction, alteration or repair of improvement to real property .
- SB 592 A
Revises Oregon Uniform Trust Code.
- SB 610 A
Modifies definitions pertaining to assistance animals for purposes of accessing places of public accommodation and places of access to state government services, programs or activities and for purposes of cause of action for harm to assistance animal.
- SB 835
States that conducting of or participation in rodeos is permitted in state.
