Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

SB 673 A

Enhances penalties for crime of trafficking in persons if victim was under 15 years of age or force was used and trafficking was for purpose of commercial sex acts.

Work Session

SB 40 A

Defines "marijuana" and "marijuana product."

Reduces unlawful manufacture of marijuana to Class B felony.

SB 482 A**

Adds saliva to category of bodily substances that may not be propelled at public safety officer under aggravated harassment statute, provided that saliva comes into physical contact with public safety officer.

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

SB 834

Increases penalty for crime of initiating false report to maximum of one year's imprisonment, \$6,250 fine, or both.
