- SB 82 A
- Eliminates suspension of driving privileges for person convicted of possessing less than one ounce of marijuana. SB 396

Exempts from execution debtor's right to assets held in, or right to receive payments under, medical savings account or health savings account.

SB 463 A

Requires Oregon Criminal Justice Commission to create, upon request of member of Legislative Assembly, racial and ethnic impact statement for proposed legislation or state measure.

SB 492 A

Requires district attorney to disclose to defendant material or information that tends to be favorable to defendant wir respect to determination of guilt, sentence to be imposed or impeachment of witness.

SB 673 A

Enhances penalties for crime of trafficking in persons if victim was under 15 years of age or force was used and trafficking was for purpose of commercial sex acts.

SB 697

Prohibits person not licensed to perform tattooing from possessing equipment used for tattooing with intent to use that equipment on another person.

SB 835

States that conducting of or participation in rodeos is permitted in state.
