Work Session

HB 2200

Allows owner of land to receive liquidated damages in amount not to exceed \$1,000 in action in which owner establishes that owner closed land to specific activities and defendant entered upon land and engaged in prohibited activities without permission of owner.

HB 2820 A

Modifies definition of "energy facility" for purposes of site certificates issued by Energy Facility Siting Council.

Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

HB 2106

Requires Director of State Department of Energy, after consultation with other state agencies and parties, to develop map that identifies areas east of summit of Cascade Mountains that are appropriate for siting of energy facilities and any related or supporting facilities.

HB 3173

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Modifies authority for establishment of winery and for winery sales and services in exclusive farm use zone.

HB 3362 **

Limits review by Land Use Board of Appeals of post-acknowledgement legislative changes to comprehensive plans and land use regulations implementing plans to issues raised during local planning process.

HB 3098

Authorizes owners of Young Life - Washington Family Ranch to develop approximately 4,000-acre expansion area
