#### Work Session

- HB 2453 A  
Requires persons operating certain high-mileage motor vehicles to pay per-mile road usage charge or flat annual road usage charge.
- HB 2894 A  
For purposes of tax credits for energy conservation projects, increases amount of eligible cost for which credit may be claimed using informational filing system in place of certification and for which entire credit may be claimed in first allowable tax year.
- HB 2480  
CARRIED OVER FROM 5-7-2013: Sunsets prohibitions against local government imposition of certain taxes.
- HB 2492  
CARRIED OVER FROM 5-7-2013: Updates connection date to federal Internal Revenue Code and other provision of federal tax law.
- HB 3477  
CARRIED OVER FROM 5-7-2013: Removes certain exemptions from taxation for out-of-state banks, extrajurisdictional institutions or foreign associations that engage in certain activities within this state.

#### Public Hearing and Work Session

- SB 183  
Allows Department of Revenue to give notice by method other than regular mail, where notice by regular mail is required, if department enters into agreement with person entitled to notice.
- SB 184  
Allows notice of garnishment to be served by first class mail or, in certain circumstances, by other methods.
- SB 185  
Creates specific provisions relating to garnishment by Department of Revenue.
- SB 330  
Makes technical changes in Oregon tax statutes.
