Public Hearing and Work Session

- SB 817
Makes certain housekeeping changes to local budget law statutes.
- SB 549 A
Extends sunset for tax exemption for federal land used by recreation facility operators under permit.
- SB 261
Exempts from property taxation certain property leased to United States in connection with electricity transmission Pacific Northwest.
- HB 2510
Eliminates requirement for homestead property tax deferral program that claimant live in homestead for at least five years and prohibition against homestead being pledged as security for reverse mortgage.
- SB 184
CARRIED OVER FROM 5-14-2013: Allows notice of garnishment to be served by first class mail or, in certain circumstances, by other methods.
- SB 185
CARRIED OVER FROM 5-14-2013: Creates specific provisions relating to garnishment by Department of Revenue.
- SB 24
CARRIED OVER FROM 5-14-2013: Specifies certain moneys to be credited to Distributable Income Account within Common School Fund.
- SB 528 A
CARRIED OVER FROM 5-14-2013: Allows Secretary of State, State Treasurer, judicial department and legislative department to obtain copyrights and patents on data processing materials and to sell, lease or otherwise make available the materials to local, state and federal governmental bodies.
