Work Session

- HB 2510
Eliminates requirement for homestead property tax deferral program that claimant live in homestead for at least five years and prohibition against homestead being pledged as security for reverse mortgage.
- HB 3495
Requires persons that facilitate like-kind exchanges to make certain notifications and to provide bonds or other securities in specified amounts.
- HB 2632
Excludes local option taxes from definition of "consolidated billing tax rate" for purposes of computing urban renew division of taxes for certain urban renewal plans.
- HB 2501 A
Extends, by five years, grants distributed to small school districts through State School Fund.
- HB 2894 A
For purposes of tax credits for energy conservation projects, increases amount of eligible cost for which credit may claimed using informational filing system in place of certification and for which entire credit may be claimed in first allowable tax year.
- SB 184
Allows notice of garnishment to be served by first class mail or, in certain circumstances, by other methods.
- SB 185
Creates specific provisions relating to garnishment by Department of Revenue.
- SB 24
Specifies certain moneys to be credited to Distributable Income Account within Common School Fund.
- SB 817
Makes certain housekeeping changes to local budget law statutes.

Public Hearing and Work Session

- SB 307 A
Withdraws Oregon from Multistate Tax Compact by repealing compact.
