Work Session

HB 2656

Requires transient lodging provider and transient lodging intermediary to collect and remit transient lodging taxes computed on total retail price, including all charges other than taxes, paid by person for occupancy of transient lodging.

HB 2503

Reduces state tax expenditures in tax year by same percentage that Oregon Department of Administrative Services and Governor reduce allotments to state agencies for same tax year.

HB 2871

Makes permanent pilot project that requires certain licensees to demonstrate and maintain tax compliance as conditi of issuance or renewal of license.

HB 2315

Directs Legislative Assembly to appropriate amount equal to one percent of total amount of General Fund appropriations and lottery allocations for next biennium to both Oregon Rainy Day Fund and Education Stability Fu if state unemployment rate for previous year is six percent or less at time of last economic and revenue forecast of biennium.

HB 2632

CARRIED OVER FROM 5-21-2013: Excludes local option taxes from definition of "consolidated billing tax rate" for purposes of computing urban renewal division of taxes for certain urban renewal plans.

HB 2501 Å

CARRIED OVER FROM 5-21-2013: Extends, by five years, grants distributed to small school districts through State School Fund.

SB 528 A

Allows Secretary of State, State Treasurer, judicial department and legislative department to obtain copyrights and patents on data processing materials and to sell, lease or otherwise make available the materials to local, state and federal governmental bodies.

Public Hearing and Work Session

SB 547 A

Authorizes cities and counties to incur exempt bonded indebtedness to finance capital costs.
