HB 3499

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Prohibits beneficiary or trustee, or beneficiary's or trustee's agent, from selling or offering for sale real property acquired as result of foreclosing residential trust deed unless beneficiary or trustee, or beneficiary's or trustee's agent, tests real property for contamination from methamphetamine manufacturing and discloses test results in writing to prospective purchaser.

HB 3500

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Requires washing machine sold in this state to carry warning label stating potential risk to small children of serious injury or drowning.

HB 3506

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Requires Secretary of State and county clerks to provide voting materials in language other than English to minority language speakers in counties in which either five percent of population or 10,000 citizens are members of single language minority community.
