HB 3316 A

Eliminates authority of Governor to appoint seven-member board of directors of mass transit district known as Tri-County Metropolitan Transportation District of Oregon.

HB 3521

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Defines "qualified designated voter registration agency." Directs qualified designated voter registration agencies to provide Secretary of State with age, residence and citizenship data and digital signature of each person who meets qualifications set by secretary by rule.

HB 3523

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Requires statements of independent expenditures to be filed with Secretary of State using electronic filing system.
