HB 3513

CARRIED OVER FROM 5/20/2013 AGENDA: Provides that matters for which quorum of governing body may not meet in private for purpose of deciding or deliberating are limited to budget, fiscal or policy matters.

Work Session

HB 3294

Exempts electronic mail addresses in possession or custody of executive department from required disclosure under public records law, except for electronic mail addresses furnished by public body to public employees.

HB 3499

Prohibits beneficiary or trustee, or beneficiary's or trustee's agent, from selling or offering for sale real property acquired as result of foreclosing residential trust deed unless beneficiary or trustee, or beneficiary's or trustee's agent tests real property for contamination from methamphetamine manufacturing and discloses test results in writing to prospective purchaser.

HB 3521

Defines "qualified designated voter registration agency." Directs qualified designated voter registration agencies to provide Secretary of State with age, residence and citizenship data and digital signature of each person who meets qualifications set by secretary by rule.

HB 3523

Requires statements of independent expenditures to be filed with Secretary of State using electronic filing system.

HB 3522

Authorizes practitioners to electronically transmit prescriptions for Schedule II controlled substances in nonemergency situations.
