## For purpose of considering replacement amendment

Allows owner of land to receive liquidated damages in amount not to exceed \$1,000 in action in which owner establishes that owner closed land to specific activities and defendant entered upon land and engaged in prohibited activities without permission of owner.

HB 3316 A

## For purpose of considering -A2 amendments

Eliminates authority of Governor to appoint seven-member board of directors of mass transit district known as Tri-County Metropolitan Transportation District of Oregon.

HB 3453

Provides that Governor may proclaim, in affected counties, public safety fiscal emergency, with unanimous agreem of President and Minority Leader of Senate and Speaker and Minority Leader of House of Representatives.

HB 3528

Exempts registered lobbyists from reporting to Oregon Government Ethics Commission moneys spent on lobbying other registered lobbyists.
