Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- HB 2261
Specifies that provisional driver license restrictions do not apply to persons 18 years of age or older.
- HB 2262
Defines commercial driving privileges for purposes of Oregon Vehicle Code.
- HB 2263 **
Establishes and adjusts certain fees for Department of Transportation. **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
- HB 2264 **
Authorizes Department of Transportation to increase rate of reimbursement for reduced-tuition traffic safety education courses provided to low-income students by public school, commercial driver training school or county. **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
- HB 2265
Permits use of photo radar in highway work zones on interstate highways and when no highway workers are present.
