The following bill, HB 2963, is being heard for the purpose of referral to the House Committee on Judiciary.

Work Session

HB 2963

Provides that state law may not be construed implicitly to preempt city's authority to control or regulate use of sidewalks.

Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

HB 2657 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Land Use

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Establishes requirements to be met by applicant before local government can consider application to rezone for nonindustrial use land that is planned and zoned for industrial use.

Public Hearing

HB 2284 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Requires Oregon Business Development Department to establish and administer Oregon Industrial Site Readiness Program to make loans to qualified project sponsors for development of certified state and regionally significant industrial sites.

HB 2285 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING - Requires Oregon Business Development Department to establish and administer Oregon Industrial Site Readiness Program providing grants to perform due diligence assessments of large industrial sites, to create detailed development plans to make large industrial sites market-ready and to conduct regional industrial site inventories.
