Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- HB 2633
Defines "honorable conditions" with regard to honorable discharge status of veteran as having meaning given in rules adopted by Department of Veterans' Affairs.
- HB 2182
Designates September 27 as annual First Responder Appreciation Day.
- HB 2183
Eliminates requirement that annual earthquake drills be conducted by employers in month of April.
