HCR 3

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Recognizes Korean veterans for their service during Vietnam War.

HB 2421

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Requires Director of Transportation to notify Director of Veterans' Affairs upon receipt of certain written information from member or veteran of uniformed service, if authorized to do so by member or veteran.

HB 2422

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Requires Director of Human Services to inform Director of Veterans' Affairs of receipt of written information from member or veteran of uniformed service only when authorized by member or veteran and upon implementation or upgrade of electronic delivery system.
