SB 1

Requires employer to provide paid or unpaid time off for Veterans Day to employees who are veterans.

HB 2034

Authorizes Office of Emergency Management, which is sole agency of state for negotiating agreements with Department of Homeland Security, to cooperate with tribal governments for purpose of acquiring and coordinating use of federal funds for emergency program management and emergency services in state.

FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Designates Emergency Communications Account as trust account exclusively for emergency communication purposes.
