- HB 2176 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Authorizes State Treasurer to issue Article XI-N general obligation bonds to finance all or portion of state share of costs of seismic rehabilitation of emergency services buildings.
