HB 2158 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Allows nonresident veterans discharged under other than dishonorable conditions to pay tuition and fees at Oregon resident rates.

HB 2162 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Removes 12-month residency requirement for admission as residents to community colleges and public universities for persons who are members of specified uniformed services and their spouses and dependents.
