- HB 3402 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Provides that certain persons who apply for driver license, driver permit or identification card be deemed to have consented to registration with Selective Service System.
- HCR 24
FIRST PUBLIC HEARING: Expresses support for creation of Veterans Treatment Court in all judicial districts.
- SJM 1
Urges Congress to develop mechanisms that provide adequate notice to states in which persons convicted in military courts of sex crimes plan to reside.
- SB 124 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Judiciary
Directs court to consider evidence received during criminal proceeding regarding defendant's status as servicemember in determining aggravation or mitigation.
- SB 32
Establishes Oregon Code of Military Justice as law governing state militia.
