CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4/9/2013 AGENDA: Urges Congress to develop mechanisms that provide adequate notice to states in which persons convicted in military courts of sex crimes plan to reside.

SB 124 **

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4/9/2013 AGENDA: Directs court to consider evidence received during criminal proceeding regarding defendant's status as servicemember in determining aggravation or mitigation. **Subsequent Referral(s) to Judiciary

SB 32

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4/9/2013 AGENDA: Establishes Oregon Code of Military Justice as law governing state militia.

HB 2158 **

Allows nonresident veterans discharged under other than dishonorable conditions to pay tuition and fees at Oregon resident rates. **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

HB 2083

Permits service member called into active service to suspend and reinstate provision of telecommunications, Internet, health spa and health club services.

HB 2086 **

Directs Oregon State Lottery Commission to establish lottery games to benefit veterans' education and economic development. **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

HJR 29 **

Proposes amendment to Oregon Constitution to include providing services to veterans among public purposes for which net proceeds of Oregon State Lottery may be spent. **Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue then to Ways and Means
