SB 191  
Authorizes Director of the Employment Department to impose penalty of up to 30 percent on overpayment of unemployment insurance benefits due to false statement, misrepresentation or nondisclosure of material fact.

SB 192  
Requires charge of benefits to employer's account if employer fails to respond timely or adequately to request for information regarding claim, failure causes overpayment of benefits and employer has pattern of failing to respond timely or adequately to requests.

SB 252  
Increases to \$100 minimum penalty for late filings of payroll and tax reports, and penalty for continued late filings of zero payroll reports, by employers.
