### **Public Hearing**

SB 807

CARRIED OVER FROM 4/2/2013 AGENDA: Requires nongovernmental entity, as condition of receiving public purpose charge moneys, to be assessed by independent third party.

#### **Work Session**

SB 254

Specifies conditions under which contracting agency may use alternative contracting method to award public improvement contract for construction manager/general contractor services.

SB 644

Permits contracting agency to directly appoint consultant to provide architectural, engineering, photogrammetric mapping, transportation planning or land surveying services if estimated value of services is less than \$100,000.

#### **Public Hearing and Possible Work Session**

SB 782

Requires state contracting agency that awards public improvement contract with contract price of more than \$5 million to set goal for apprentices to perform certain percentage, not to exceed 10 percent, of work hours on public improvement that workers in apprenticeable occupations perform.

SB 361

SB 392
