HB 2195

Provides that physician or health care provider may at any time report to Department of Transportation that person's cognitive or functional impairment affects person's ability to safely operate motor vehicle, without regard to whethe report is required by department.

HB 2261

Specifies that provisional driver license restrictions do not apply to persons 18 years of age or older.

HB 2262 A

Defines commercial driving privileges for purposes of Oregon Vehicle Code.

HB 2264

Authorizes Department of Transportation to increase rate of reimbursement for reduced-tuition traffic safety education courses provided to low-income students by public school, commercial driver training school or county.

HB 2517

Provides exception for citizens of certain countries to have driver license or identification card for eight years even length of stay in United States is unknown.
