- HB 2268
  - Clarifies qualifications for firms providing architectural services.
- HB 2406 A

Provides that person does not commit offense of obstruction of vehicle windows by covering rear window. HB 2630

- Requires person to yield right of way to county-operated transit bus entering traffic.
- HB 3136

Allows court to dismiss citation issued for offense of operating vehicle with illegal window tinting, or to reduce fine that court would otherwise have imposed for offense, if defendant establishes that tinting has been modified to comply with statutory requirements.
