Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- HB 2524 A
Limits exemption from construction contractor licensing requirement for financial institutions, subsidiaries, real estate managers and suppliers of workers.
- HB 2535 A
Prohibits client of temporary service provider from paying employee provided by temporary service provider directly if employee is being paid by temporary service provider.
- HB 2540 A
Allows Construction Contractors Board to revoke, suspend or refuse to issue license if board finds person has engaged in dishonesty by enabling evasion of certain obligations.
- HB 3435 A
Increases number of locations for which distillery licensee may permit tastings of distillery products.
- HB 3438 **
Permits any city to operate photo radar in school zone while school is in session. **Subsequent Referral(s) to Judiciary

- HB 2004 A
Modifies circumstances under which additional moneys may be collected from residential electricity consumers under public purpose charge expenditure standard.
