HB 3347 B

Prohibits motor vehicle manufacturer, distributor or importer from requiring dealer to construct new dealer facility or materially alter or remodel existing dealer facility within seven years after date on which dealer previously constructed, materially altered or remodeled existing dealer facility if existing dealer facility complies with manufacturer's, distributor's or importer's approved brand image standards or plans that existed at time dealer constructed, materially altered.

HB 3415 A

Requires public body acting as radio common carrier to charge market rate for access to radio tower for delivery of radio communications service, radio paging or cellular communications service for hire.

Permits use of photo radar in highway work zones on interstate highways and when no highway workers are present.

HB 2311

Adds criteria used to select projects within Statewide Transportation Improvement Program.

HB 2535 A

Prohibits client of temporary service provider from paying employee provided by temporary service provider directly if employee is being paid by temporary service provider.

HB 3438 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Judiciary

Permits any city to operate photo radar in school zone while school is in session.
