Possible Introduction of Committee Measures

Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- SB 222 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Expands purposes for which grants awarded for accelerated college credit programs may be used.
- SB 139
Allows Oregon Education Investment Board to authorize Secretary of State to have access to education records of students in public education system for auditing purposes under federal Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act.
- SB 105 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Clarifies method by which moneys are transferred from State School Fund to Regional Educational Services Account for use by Office of Regional Educational Services.

Public Hearing

- SB 500 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Tax Credits
Creates tax credits for educational expenses or for contributions to qualified scholarship granting organization.
- SJR 23 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Rules
Proposes amendment to Oregon Constitution allowing income and excise tax credits for educational expenses paid to or for benefit of religion-based schools.
