HB 2187 A

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/21/2013 AGENDA: Exempts school from career school licensure requirements if school prepares students to become nursing assistant or medication aide and meets certain standards or if school is adequately regulated by other means and Superintendent of Public Instruction grants exemption.

HB 2189

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/21/2013 AGENDA: Allows State Board of Education to adopt rules related to general governance and operation of career schools.

SB 227 **

Relating to education service districts; declaring an emergency.

SB 270

Establishes institutional boards for University of Oregon and Portland State University.

SB 755

Broadens definition of term "minority" for purpose of Minority Teacher Act.

SB 600

Directs district boundary board to accept petition from city for change in school district boundaries if certain conditions met.

Public Hearing and Work Session

HB 2756 A

Prohibits public education program from purchasing, building or otherwise taking possession of seclusion cell or from using seclusion cells.

HB 2753

Removes sunset on provisions related to use of restraint or seclusion on student in public education program.

Removes requirements related to assessments for extended diplomas.
