- HB 2150 A
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 05/09/2013 AGENDA: Modifies contents of and process for proposal to establish public charter school.
- HB 2192 A
Establishes requirements for school policies related to discipline, suspension or expulsion.

Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- HB 2747 A
Describes student characteristics that district school board that admits nonresident students by giving consent or that charges nonresident students tuition is prohibited from considering when determining whether to give consent or accept nonresident student or when establishing terms of consent or amount of tuition.
- HB 2757
Directs Department of Education to ensure that statewide assessment system, or alternative to statewide assessment system, is available for students whose primary language is American Sign Language.
- HB 3254 A**
Establishes instructor license and teacher leader license. **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
- HB 3341 A
Exempts public universities and community colleges from requirement to enter into agreement with for-profit institutions of higher education before implementing potentially duplicative new post-secondary programs.
