HB 2640 B

HB 2898

HB 2995

Requires each public university, community college or other institution of higher education to allow students, faculty and staff to identify sexual orientation on forms used to collect demographic data.

HB 2749 A

Requires school district boards to allow certain medications to be kept in student's classroom if requested by student's parent or guardian and other conditions are met.

HB 2958 A

Requires community colleges to annually make available for distribution specified information about community colleges to public school students in grades 11 and 12.
