##### Public Hearing and Work Session

- SCR 14  
Designates oregonite and josephinite as official twin minerals of State of Oregon.
- SB 287  
Makes person allowing livestock to run at large subject to reduced maximum penalty if certain conditions met.

##### Work Session

- SB 179  
Clarifies that State Aviation Board rules governing seaplane safety and operations shall be adopted in agreement with State Marine Board and State Parks and Recreation Department.
- SB 401  
Designates certain rivers and creeks as scenic waterways.
- SB 476 \*\*  
Requires agencies to prepare environmental impact statements before approving certain applications and before making certain decisions. \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
- SB 488  
Repeals sunset on provisions related to low carbon fuel standards.
- SB 790  
Creates offense of equine tripping.
- SB 800  
Requires reporting of commercial or governmental pesticide applications to Department of Environmental Quality.
- SB 837 \*\*  
Creates Fish Passage Restoration Subaccount within Fish Passage Fund. \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
- SB 838 \*\*  
Imposes moratorium on certain mining using any form of motorized equipment. \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
