- HB 3096 A
Permits nonprofit and for-profit water improvement companies to own and operate sanitary sewer services and include existing sewer systems in land improvement plans.
- HB 2820 B
Modifies definition of "energy facility" for purposes of site certificates issued by Energy Facility Siting Council.
- HB 3441 A
Establishes Oregon Hatchery Research Center Board.

Work Session

- HB 2005 A
Makes temporary findings of state's best interest regarding mechanical insulation standards and mechanical systems
- HB 2025 A
Establishes economic damages liability of owner or possessor of bison running at large or of person allowing bison to run at large.
- HB 2031
Designates Department of State Lands as state agency that acts for state in transactions concerning mineral and geothermal resource rights in low-potential resource real property.
- HB 2032 A
Sets forth requirements for payments for off-site compensatory mitigation to Oregon Removal-Fill Mitigation Fund
- HB 2801 A
Authorizes public purpose charge moneys invested on cost-effective local energy conservation that involve updating energy efficiency of residential or nonresidential building to be used for purpose of conducting whole building assessment of energy efficiency of building.
