Public Hearing and Work Session

SB 259

Authorizes Director of Employment Department to enter into intergovernmental agreement with federal government to offset against state debt moneys owed to debtor by federal government.

SB 184

Allows notice of garnishment to be served by first class mail or, in certain circumstances, by other methods.

Work Session

SB 330

Makes technical changes in Oregon tax statutes.

SB 183

Allows Department of Revenue to give notice by method other than regular mail, where notice by regular mail is required, if department enters into agreement with person entitled to notice.
