Urges Acting Secretary of Commerce and United States Trade Representative to investigate extent of subsidies China grants to Chinese paper manufacturers and whether subsidies violate World Trade Organization rules, and to evaluate impact Chinese subsidies have on United States paper manufacturers.

SJM 7

Urges Congress to require United States Department of Labor to adopt standard rules and procedures for application and enforcement of certain provision of Fair Labor Standards Act.

SB 789

Clarifies that only certain districts claiming exception from requirement to offer benefits provided and administered by Oregon Educators Benefit Board must undergo actuarial analysis by board to maintain exception.

Public Hearing

SB 489

Repeals requirement that certain local governments make health care insurance coverage available to certain retirees.
