CARRIED OVER FROM 3/22/2013 AGENDA: Requires beneficiary under residential trust deed to request resolution conference with grantor for purposes of negotiating foreclosure avoidance measure, unless beneficiary is eligible to claim exemption from requirement.

#### SB 413

Limits public comment period for premium rate filings by individual, portability or small employer health insurers t health benefit plans offered by those insurers.

#### SJM 7

Urges Congress to require United States Department of Labor to adopt standard rules and procedures for application and enforcement of certain provision of Fair Labor Standards Act.

SB 96
