**Possible Introduction of Committee Measures**

**Work Session**

- SB 558  
Requires beneficiary under residential trust deed to request resolution conference with grantor for purposes of negotiating foreclosure avoidance measure, unless beneficiary is eligible to claim exemption from requirement.
- SB 814  
Provides that general liability insurance policy that contains provisions requiring consent of insurance company before rights under policy are assigned may not prohibit assignment in certain cases.

**Public Hearing**

- SB 570  
Establishes foster parents as public employees for purposes of labor organization activities.
- SB 683  
Prohibits health care practitioners from referring patients to health care entities in which practitioner has beneficial interest or with which practitioner has compensation arrangement, subject to specified exceptions.
- SB 785  
Requires entities that use public financing for capital construction to report to Legislative Assembly on use of local goods, services and labor.

**Public Hearing and Possible Work Session**

- SB 74  
Changes calculation of present value of adjusted premiums for certain types of life insurance so that present value of all adjusted premiums equals 50 percent of adjusted premium for first policy year instead of 40 percent of adjusted premium for first policy year.
- SB 744  
Requires council on civil rights appointed by Commissioner of the Bureau of Labor and Industries to study wage equality in Oregon and report findings to Legislative Assembly.
