**Work Session**

- SB 558  
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4/3/2013 AGENDA: Requires beneficiary under residential trust deed to request resolution conference with grantor for purposes of negotiating foreclosure avoidance measure, unless beneficiary is eligible to claim exemption from requirement.
- SB 814  
CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4/3/2013 AGENDA: Provides that general liability insurance policy that contains provisions requiring consent of insurance company before rights under policy are assigned may not prohibit assignment in certain cases.
- SB 520  
Changes amount of credit union assets that require credit union to obtain fidelity bond or irrevocable letter of credit from financial institution and amount of fidelity bond or irrevocable letter of credit required.

**Public Hearing and Possible Work Session**

- SB 140  
Directs state government bodies that request individuals to disclose Social Security numbers to inform individuals that Social Security numbers may be used in matching with other public records for purposes of state auditing.
- SB 573  
Establishes right of employee for civil action based on unpaid wages.
- SB 768  
Establishes Oregon Civil Rights Network.
- SB 805  
Permits employee of contracting agency that conducts cost analysis or determines feasibility of procurement, or exclusive representative of employee's bargaining unit, to seek judicial review of cost analysis or determination.
