Possible Introduction of Committee Measures

Work Session

SB 322 **
Extends sunset for tax credit for closure of manufactured dwelling park.

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Tax Credits

Public Hearing

SB 74
Changes calculation of present value of adjusted premiums for certain types of life insurance so that present value of all adjusted premiums equals 50 percent of adjusted premium for first policy year instead of 40 percent of adjusted premium for first policy year.

Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

SB 344
Establishes unlawful employment practice for certain actions taken by employer to access employee's or prospective employee's personal account on social networking website for employment purposes.

SB 435
Modifies restoration rights of certain state exempt and management service employees to classified position in state service held prior to appointment to exempt or management service position.

SB 489
Repeals requirement that certain local governments make health care insurance coverage available to certain retirees.

SB 613
Reduces amount of continuing education required for vehicle dealers.

SB 615
Prohibits Department of Transportation from imposing civil penalty on vehicle dealer if vehicle dealer fails to submit notice of sale to department.

SB 684
Specifies requirements for persons to intervene in contested case proceedings conducted by Department of Consumer and Business Services on rate filings.

April 10, 2013

- SB 747
Prohibits certain cities from entering into collective bargaining agreement that provides for binding arbitration of issues related to disciplining or termination of city police officer for misconduct involving unlawful use of force.
- SB 804 **
Requires grantor that seeks mediation with trustee before foreclosure proceedings to provide mediation service provider with certain documents. **Subsequent Referral(s) to Judiciary

Public Hearing

- SB 648 **
Directs appropriation bills to contain itemized list of state agency expenditures related to public employee compensation. **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
