SB 322 **

Extends sunset for tax credit for closure of manufactured dwelling park.

Public Hearing

SB 74

Changes calculation of present value of adjusted premiums for certain types of life insurance so that present value o all adjusted premiums equals 50 percent of adjusted premium for first policy year instead of 40 percent of adjusted premium for first policy year.

Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

SB 344

Establishes unlawful employment practice for certain actions taken by employer to access employee's or prospective employee's personal account on social networking website for employment purposes.

SB 435

Modifies restoration rights of certain state exempt and management service employees to classified position in state service held prior to appointment to exempt or management service position.
