- HB 2059
Requires consignee to refrain from certain practices and to hold moneys consignee receives from sale of personal property in trust account if consignee does not pay moneys immediately to person that offered, gave or entrusted personal property to consignee.
- HB 2066 A
Allows certain personal property to be used as pledge for pledge loan from pawnbroker.
- HB 2112 A
Authorizes imposition of civil penalty by Bureau of Labor and Industries for certain actions relating to deductions from compensation paid to employees.
- HB 2207 A
Requires payment of state payroll and itemized statement of payroll deductions to be provided to recipient electronically unless recipient requests to receive payment by check or to receive paper statement of itemized deductions.
- HB 2383 A
Prohibits merchant from requiring statement of account as condition for cardholder to obtain refund of amount in payment card transaction.
- HB 3070 A
Requires disclosure of shipping and handling charges in sale or advertisement of consumer good.
- HB 3168
Requires Oregon Department of Administrative Services to adopt rules for purposes of establishing statewide criteria by which certain qualified entities and authorized agencies conduct criminal records checks for purposes other than criminal justice.
- HB 3409 A
Defines "natural hair care." Specifies that person who is certified to practice hair design or barbering is authorized to practice natural hair care.
